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


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Surgery

- 20% no response to surgery
- 32% placebo response



Abbott et al 2004

- 1st surgery 83% reduction in pain
- 2nd surgery 53% reduction in pain

- 20% recurrence disease





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
Pelvis and Ligaments, Rear View, Female

- Ultrasound - normal





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Case I: Natalie

Assessment

- Normal neurological exam
- No pelvic girdle tenderness
- Abdominal wall hyperesthesia
- High tender cul de sac
- Pelvic floor myalgia

Case 1: Natalie

Management

- Amitriptyline
- NSAIDs
- COCP
- Physiotherapy
- Internet based CBT
- Laparoscopy

Case 1: Natalie

Management

- Improvement
 - Dysmenorrhoea
 - NMPP
 - Neck pain
- Dyschezia predominant
- Laparoscopy
 - Stage 3 endometriosis
 - Pararectal space
 - Weaning Endep at 6 months
 - Physiotherapy

Case 2: Melissa

Pregnancy

- 31yo
- G1P1 6 months postpartum
- LSCS
- Right sided abdominal pain
- Sacral pain
- Apareunia

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

Case 3: Natalie

Pregnancy

- Challenging!
- Pain is not normal
- Unexplained
 - Visceral bias
- Early recognition
- Multifactorial



Case 3: Natalie

Persistent Postpartum Pain

- Dyspareunia
- Pelvic girdle
- Coccyx
- Neuralgia
 - Perineal tear/episiotomy
 - Caesarean

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Red Flags

- Infection
- VTE
- Neurological
- Sacral fractures
 - Osteoporosis
- Postnatal depression



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
Pelvic Girdle Pain

- Between PSIS and gluteal fold
- Posterior thigh
- Reduced ability to stand/walk/sit
- Exclude lumbar causes

- Skin split
- Cotton tip
- Single finger exam
- Pelvic floor
- Pudendal nerve





<p>Wound Neuralgia</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ?Iliohypogastric/inguinal neuralgia • Hip flexion <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Getting out of bed – Stairs • Finger test <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Lateral border rectus

Postpartum
<p>Management</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prevention <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Exercise in pregnancy – Mode of delivery? • Physical therapy <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Not just pelvic floor strength! • TENS

Postpartum
<p>Management</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paracetamol • NSAIDs • TCAs • Topical <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Oestriol – Amitriptyline • Gabapentinoids • Opioids

Postpartum
<p>Management</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Focussed intervention • Iliohypogastric/inguinal block • Pudendal blocks <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Hyaluronic acid – Pulsed radiofrequency • Impar ganglion • Fractional CO₂ laser

- Distressed
- MMSE
- Romberg's positive
- Punctate allodynia right labia
- Levator myalgia

Management

- Neurology
- Rheumatology
- Pudendal nerve block
 - Transgluteal

Case 3: Helen

Criteria of Nantes

- Pain in distribution of pudendal nerve
- Pain worse with sitting
- No pain at night
- No sensory impairment
- Pain relieved by pudendal nerve bl

Management

- On mirtazepine
 - Tricyclic?
 - SNRI?
 - Sjogren's
- Buprenorphine
- Gabapentinoid
- Valproate

Management

- Physiotherapy
 - Sit cushion
 - Limited self management
- Psychology
 - Pacing
 - Catastrophisation

 - Repeat




