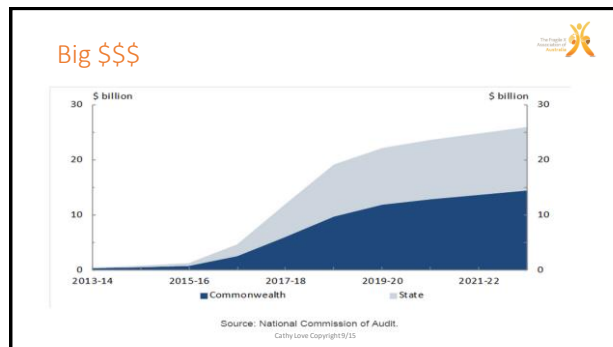
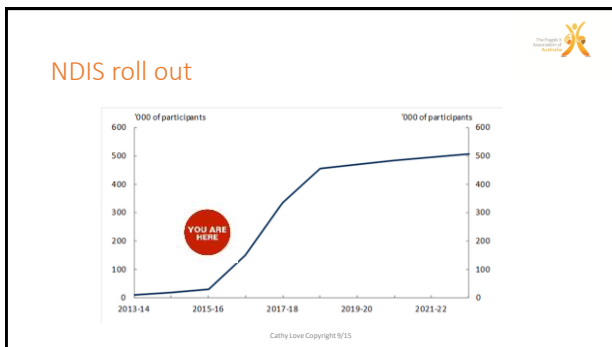



NDIS... 3 profound changes

Fragile X Syndrome


Most common cause of inherited intellectual disability

The single gene cause of ASD, to date

Affect boys and girls differently


1 Australian child per week born with FXS

90 – 100, 000 Australians impacted by FXS



FXS full mutation characteristics

- Range of ID and LD (80% have IQ < 80)
- Developmental delay
- Speech and communication difficulties
 - Echolalic, repetitive speech,
- Anxiety, social anxiety, poor eye contact
- AD +/- HD
- ASD type behaviours
- Sensory processing differences
- Fine and gross motor coordination issues
 - Lower muscle tone, lax joints, balance,




FXS Carriers

Variable cognitive challenges

- 50% with executive function issues
- Learning difficulties
- Time management, scheduling, diary use,
- Math skills, money management
- Appointments, paper trail, holding info





Social challenges and anxiety

40% Anxiety / Depression

- (Australian average is approx. 10%)
