

# FAQs - Screening for Murmurs in Elderly Patients – A Mini Audit

## Is this activity accredited?

Follow the prompts - Click access this course and enrol for free button.


- 1. Watch the video lecture by Dr Nicholas Aroney on early detection of aortic stenosis for better outcomes
- 2. Identify patients who:
  - Are over 65 years-of-age
  - o Is a regular patient over the past year
- 3. Randomly select 10 patients that fit the profile above



- 4. Download the mini-audit report/template provided within the module (see image 1 below)
- 5. Complete the questions outlined in the mini-audit report/template. These questions will involve:
  - Documenting the findings for each patient
  - Writing a reflection on the clinical importance of regular cardiac auscultation and how you might change your practice and approach as a result of this activity
- 6. Submit the mini-audit report back to Healthed within the module where it says "submit assignment" (see image 1 below)
- 7. Log your CPD here:
  - Complete the survey. Make sure you click the red START button to complete and answer all the questions and click submit at the end (see image 2 and 3 below).

Important! You must complete records for all 10 patients for Healthed to approve your submission.


